Participants will use variegated hemp cord to create small medallions of rainbow colors. The simple stitches produce a variety of textures to combine on a washed river stone (or other objects). The resulting embellished trinket can be used as a memento or hostess gift.

Some students may be able to make more than one.

PINE NEEDLE JEWELRY

Learn how to make jewelry (pins, pendants and earrings) with Canary Island pine needles as the bezel, to set semiprecious stones.

Approximate size: 3-1/2"

PINE NEEDLE BASKETRY AROUND A FOUND OBJECT

Class fee includes all materials: \$50.

Learn to coil a pine needle basket around a found object. Emphasis will be on regular spacing of stitches. The swirl stitch and wrap stitch will be executed.

Materials supplied: Pine needles, waxed linen and coins, stones, buttons, etc., will be provided ready to use.

Tools to bring: Small sharp scissors, needle nose pliers, small object to mount. *(You will learn how to mount your own object during class, but it will not be ready to use for 24 hours.)*

Approximate size: 4" x 4" by 2" height
